The children were alleged victims of at least one type of abuse, some more than one:

22% Physical abuse  
11% Neglect  
8% Witness to violence  
5% Emotional abuse  
13% Other type of abuse

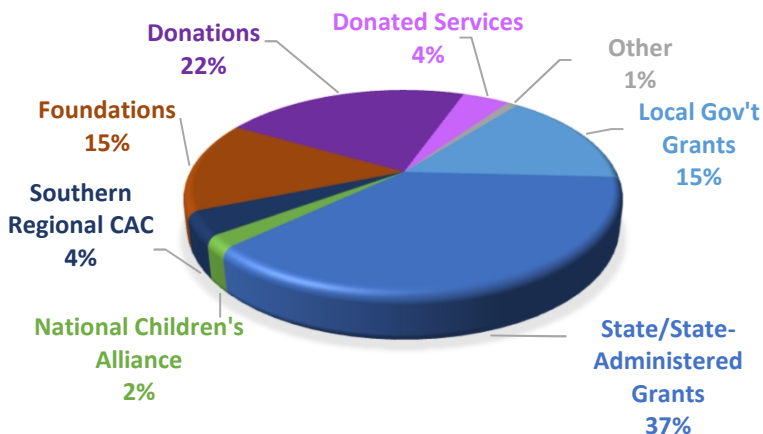

"Everyone was very understanding and listened to what I had to say...They made me feel like [helping my child] is a priority to them."

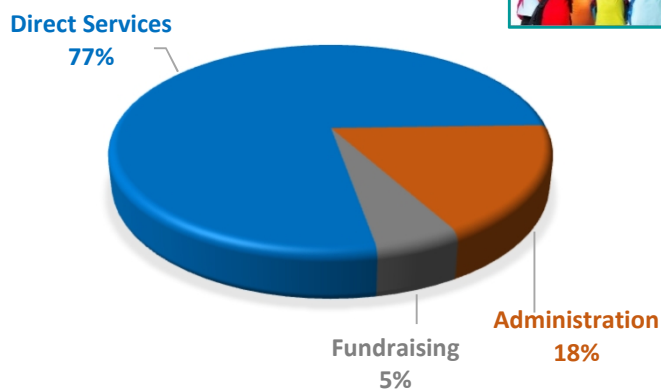

### Notable Fundraising Achievements

- 25% increase in total amount of non-government funded contributions over FY 2015 (from \$110,835 to \$139,115)
